Dear Hotma Rumahorbo,

It is with great regret that Global Journal of Health Science, is delisted from Scopus and SCIMAGO coverage. We found that the SCImago Team has provided the clarification on this issue.

"As you said, our data come from Scopus/Elsevier, which offers an annual copy of their database. All the metadata have been provided by Scopus /Elsevier in their last update sent to SCImago (May 2020), including the Coverage's period data. Besides, as the SJR is a static image of a Scopus (which is changing every da), we always recommend our users to consult the Scopus database directly.

Concerning your questions, we understand that, since the date indicated by Scopus/Elsevier (2016), the journal is no longer indexed in its database. However, while the Citation Window is still active in Scopus, SCImago can show scientometric indicators for the journal (up to three years). Therefore, a journal can be SJR and not being indexed in Scopus.

We hope that this information clarifies your doubts.
