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Midwifery care for Mrs. T 40 years old with severe preeclampsia at Salak Hospital, Bogor City, VI BAB, 63 pages, 6 attachments, 2 tables

ABSTRACT

The maternal mortality ratio in 2013 was 210 maternal deaths / 100,000 live births due to complications of pregnancy or childbirth and 99% occurred in developing countries. The cause of preeclampsia is not clearly known but there are risk factors that cause preeclampsia, namely age, parity, genetic factors, multiple pregnancies, past disease history and nutritional status. The impact caused by preeclampsia on the mother can be eclampsia, HELLP syndrome, kidney failure, heart failure, pulmonary edema and the impact on the fetus can cause IUGR, prematurity, fetal death, hypoxia. Based on data from the Salak Hospital, Bogor City, 5.75% of mothers who experienced severe preeclampsia. The purpose of writing this final report is to provide midwifery care to Mrs. T 40 years old G4P3A0 37 weeks pregnant with severe preeclampsia.

The writing method uses the case report method in SOAP documentation, the approach technique used is midwifery management, and data collection techniques through interviews, physical examinations, and support, observations, literature studies.

Subjective data obtained on Ny. T, 40 years old, the mother said this was her fourth pregnancy, she had never had a miscarriage, complained of dizziness and blurred vision, had a history of hypertension and a previous history of severe preeclampsia. Objective data obtained blood pressure 222/162 mmHg, there is edema in both legs, urine examination 2+. The analysis obtained by Mrs. T 40 years old G4P3A0 37 weeks pregnant with severe preeclampsia. The management provided in collaboration with dr SPOG for the provision of therapy and action is the administration of antihypertensive drugs, catheter placement, oxygen administration, bed rest, administration of MgSO₄ 40% 4 g and MgSO₄ 40% 6 g to prevent seizures, informed consent regarding caesarean section.

The conclusion in this case the midwife performs care in accordance with the authority. It is hoped that the hospital can maintain the quality of service.
