The authors have carried out a cross-sectional study demonstrating that integrative counselling enhances female sex workers' knowledge about sexually transmitted infections.

The sample size is very small and the authors have not described their methods and study design in sufficient detail. The setting is unknown and the topics covered in counselling are very vague. Also, statistical analysis is not robust.

Although the authors depict that counselling is useful, the findings are not novel and are already well-known, hence not adding much value to existing literature.
