**ABSTRACT**

*A normal newborn is a baby born from 37 to 42 weeks of pregnancy and a birth weight of 2500 - 4000 grams and must adjust from intra-uterine life to extra-uterine life. Things that may happen if care is not done in newborns are hypothermia which can cause hypoxia or hypoglycemia and result in brain damage. Hypothermy is one of the main causes of illness and death of BBl. In Indonesia, around 17.9% of neonates experience hypothermia, The purpose of writing this final project report is to provide obstetric care for Baby Mrs. I at the Leuwiliang Health Center.*

*The method used in the preparation of the Final Project Report uses case reports and documentation in the form of SOAP. The data collection technique uses Interview techniques, Physical Examination, Documentation Studies and Literature Studies.*

*From the results of the subjective data assessment of Mrs. I, 20 years old G1P0A0, first dayo f the last menstruation June 14, 2023, interpretation of childbirth March 21, 2024, Gestational age 40 weeks, this is the first child, has never had a miscarriage, gave birth normally on Tuesday, March 26, 2024 at 13.20 WIB. The objective data showed that the general condition was good, body weight 3,600 grams, body length 50 cm, head circumference 35 cm, chest circumference 34 cm. Based on subjective and objective data, the diagnosis of Mrs. I Neonatal Babies at Term According to the Pregnancy Period can be established in good condition. The management of care is in accordance with essential neonatal services, namely physical examination of newborns, maintaining warmth, Initiating Early Breastfeeding, providing eye ointment, providing Vitamin K1, providing Hepatitis B immunization, exclusive breastfeeding.*

*In conclusion, after taking care of Baby Mrs. I, it was found that the general condition was good. The advice given to Mrs. I is to provide exclusive breastfeeding, do umbilical cord treatment, and make a follow-up visit to health workers.*
