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**Midwifery Care for Labor in Mrs. N with Chronic Hypertension at Ciawi Hospital

ABSTRACT

The maternal mortality rate in Indonesia in 2020 is 189/100,000 live births. One of the causes of morbidity and mortality throughout the world for both the mother and the fetus. According to the World Health Organization (WHO) in 2020, the incidence of hypertension in pregnant women ranks second in the cause of maternal morbidity and mortality worldwide at 12%. One of the causes of morbidity and mortality worldwide for both mother and fetus.

Hypertension is one of the complications of pregnancy and an important problem in obstetrics. The purpose of care in this case was to understand and provide midwifery care to Mrs. N, 29 years old with Chronic Hypertension at Ciawi Hospital. The method used was a case report. The form of documentation was SOAP (subjective, objective, analysis, management) while data collection techniques were obtained through interviews, observation, physical examination, laboratory tests, documentation studies, and literature studies.

Subjective data assessment results Mrs. N aged 29 years, first day of last menstruation on July 08, 2023 with complaints of high blood pressure or hypertension experienced before pregnancy. Objective data assessment of good general condition, conscious, vital sign within high limits, namely 160/90 mmHg, height of the fundal height 27 cm, fetal heartbeat 147x/minute regularly, vaginal toucher's result showed that there was no cervix dilatation.

The care provided to patients was in accordance with the hospital's SOP. After providing care to Mrs. N the patient experienced changes in blood pressure after delivery, and the mother did not experience complications of chronic hypertension.
