ABSTRACT

Midwifery care prioritizes continuity of care is very important for women to get services from a professional, because that way the development of their conditions will be monitored at any time as well as they become more trustworthy and open because they already know the care giver. Physiological changes due to pregnancy can be caused by the limited ability of the organ system to get more burden and cause deterioration in physical condition. Of all these conditions, the biggest cause of maternal death each year is post-partum hemorrhage

Scientific paper report uses a case study method involving a respondent, namely a pregnant woman with 36-37 weeks gestational age who is given comprehensive midwifery care using Midwifery management.

During the treatment process there are several problems during pregnancy, childbirth, postpartum, and newborns. The problem that arises is after the delivery of labor after sewing the mother had bleeding around 550cc care provided is to do uterine massage and give 20 UI oxytocin through 500ml of intravenous fluids. During the postpartum period of 12 hours the mother complained of stitching pain care provided is early mobilization and personal hygiene counseling. The red rash appears at the age of 14 days the care given is to keep the baby clean, create a cool atmosphere, and provide baby clothes that absorb swaet and not too narrow. All problems are resolved and there are changes after being given midwifery care.

Comprehensive midwifery care can be developed by midwives in accordance with midwifery care standards and the authority of midwives, so that the results of care are healthy mothers and babies.
